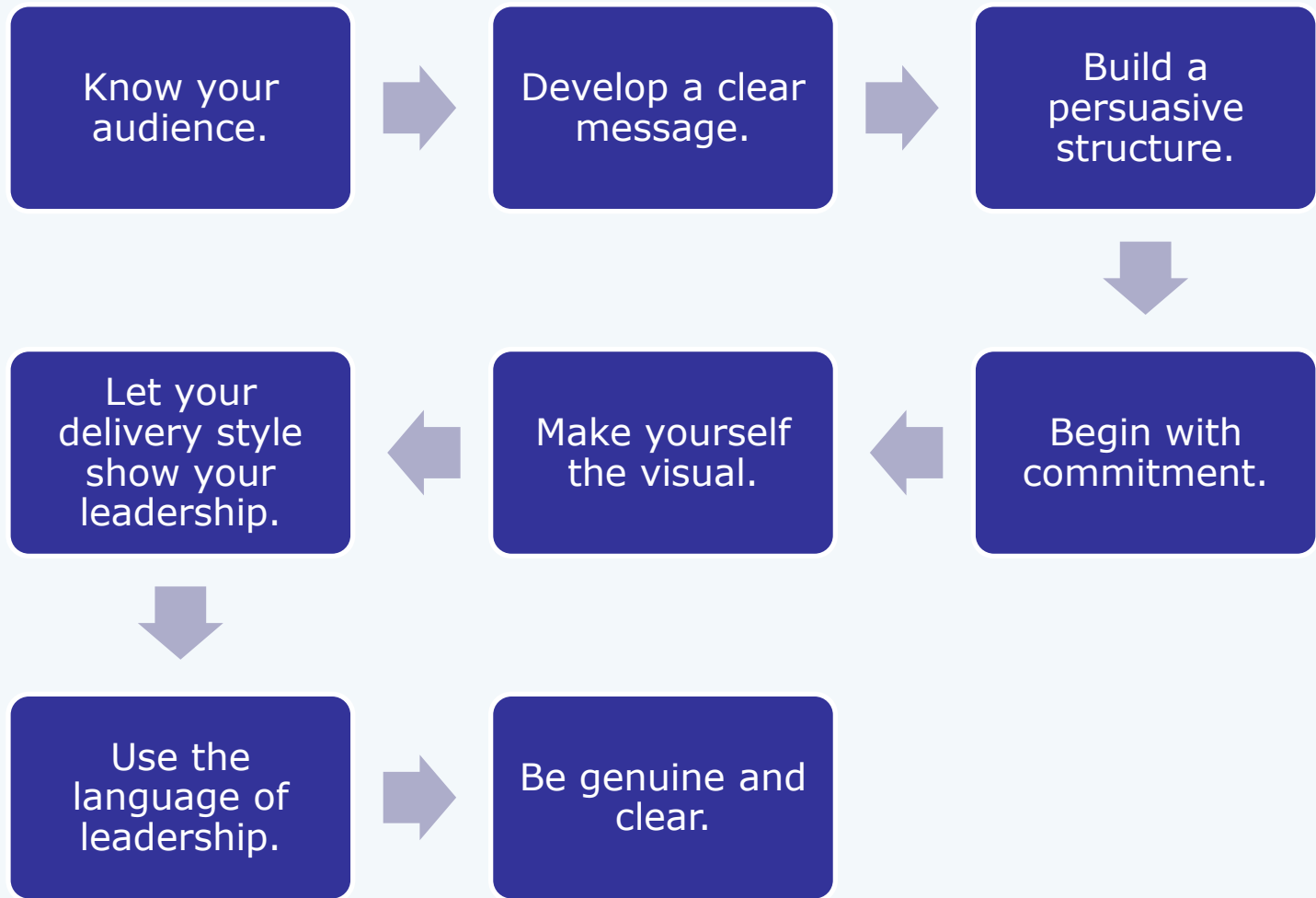

- ✦ The demands of the situation



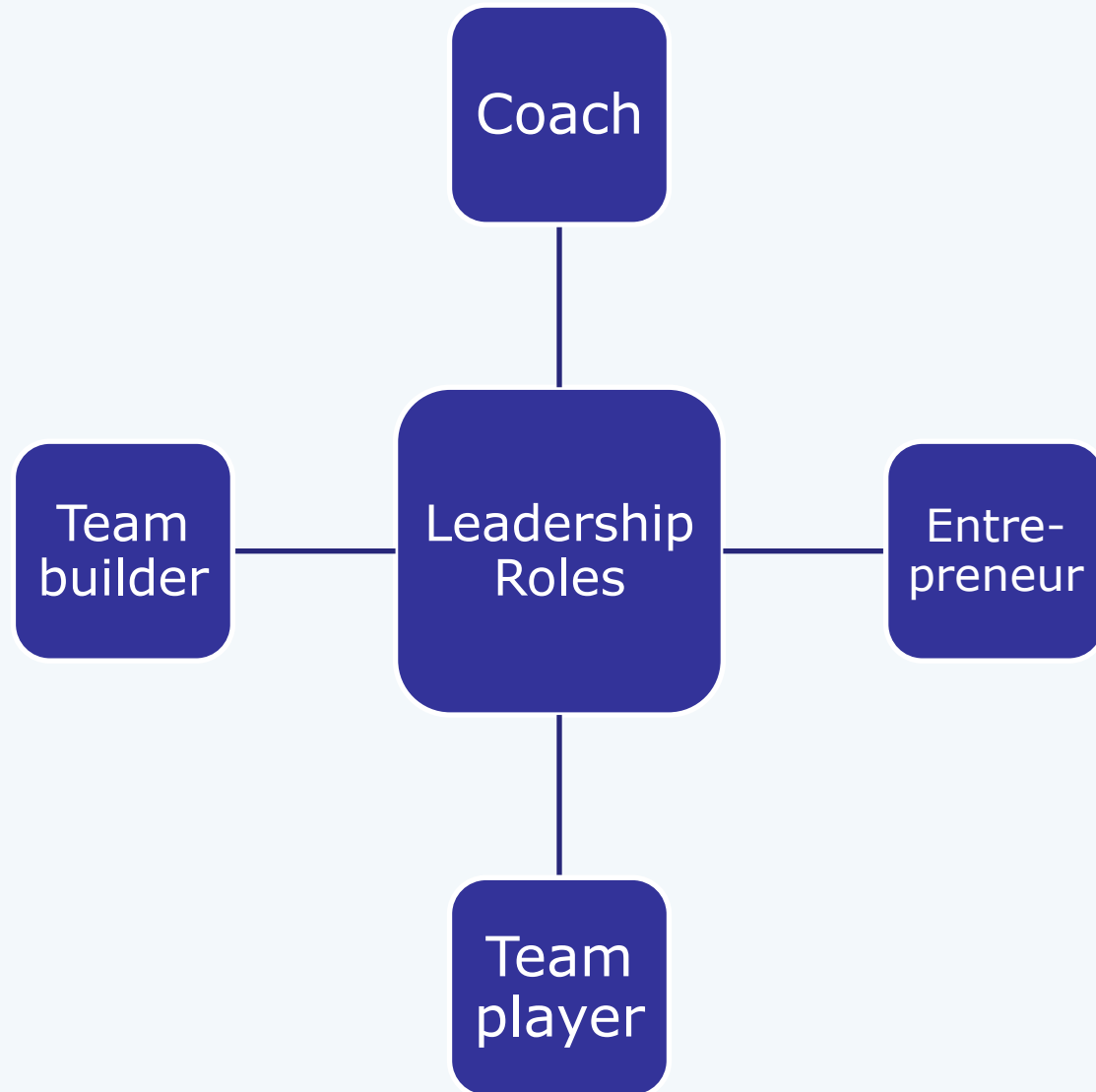
# Why People Need Leaders
